The summaries of published reports on procurement could not be used and the approach **should be** adapted to make them **more readily available and useful to the auditors** of the SAIs.

- the database would be available for SAIs with **direct access** and special authorization for the contact person of SAI (liaison officer, auditor, ...)

- 3. info






#### Access to the proposed database

# Access allowed to administrators or WG members:

- 1. Reading
- 2. Classifying all folders, files, data
- 3. Uploading data
- 4. Changing all folders and file titles
- 5. Deleting all folders, files, data
- 6. Withdrawing data

#### **Access allowed to SAI's representatives:**

- 1. Reading
- 2. Uploading data
- 3. Changing and deleting own files and own files titles
- 4. Withdrawing data





#### Module 1 - Reports

Reports – the database of reports published by SAIs will be in their native language or in English (if it is available). SAIs would fill this database with their reports and they could read and withdraw other reports.


#### Module 2 - Guidelines

**Guidelines** - the database will consist of guidelines published or used by SAIs in their native language or in English (if it is available). SAIs would fill this database with their guidelines and they could read and withdraw the other guidelines.





#### Structure of Module 2 - Guidelines






#### Module 3 - Info

Info – the database will contain basic information about a particular person from each SAI in English (it can be used, for example, to get more detailed information about findings, procedures, experience, etc.)
